Bank accounts: Checking account statement
Bank accounts: Savings account statement
Stocks, Bonds & Securities statements.
Motor Vehicles & Trailers and valuation.
Non-exempt Personal Property
• 1 st Time Applicants Seniors: Birth Certificate or Drivers' License.
1 st Time Applicants Surviving Spouse: Death Certificate of spouse.

The deadline to be placed on the Actual Tax Bill for FY 2025 is November 1, 2024 by 5:00 pm. The state deadline is April 1, 2025 by 5:00 pm. If we do not receive this information, you will not receive your exemption for your property. Incomplete applications will be returned for completion.
